## About Samvada

YOUTH WORK effectively integrates youth rights and responsibilities, their entitlements and their active role in social change. The course focuses on young individuals with a vision for inclusive, gender just, plural, democratic and sustainable world.

## Why is Samvada offering this course?

- To build a cadre of youth work professionals with perspectives, sensitivities, skills and values needed for working with youth.
- To create competent and committed youth workers who can foster a humane, sustainable and peaceful society in partnership with youth.

## Who is the Course For?

- Any individual interested in youth work
- For staff of civil society organizations willing to initiate youth focused programmes

Prerequisite: Graduation in any discipline and should be above 24 years of age. The medium of instruction will be Kannada.

## Course Duration

Total duration : One and half months split into 2 modules of 13 days each and field work and research in between.

First module : 24 Sep to 6 Oct 2018

Second module : 22 Oct to 3 Nov 2018

## Course Content

The course is designed with four streams of learning and working , along with interactive and creative activities like individual and group exercises, theatre, music, films and discussions.
